This two-day virtual workshop will bring together renewable energy and policy experts from Europe and Africa to discuss renewable energy development and deployment, energy policy intersections and challenges, EU-Africa competing interests, and geopolitical dimensions of renewable energy cooperation between Europe and Africa, and the formation of strong EU-Africa cooperation for renewable energy transitions under the EU Green Deal. The workshop aims to understand better the intricacies and geopolitics of renewable energy transitions in EU-Africa collaboration, spark in-depth national and regional conversations about renewable energy policy, the EU Green Deal and renewable energy transitions, energy democracy, energy infrastructure, and power balance to support renewable energy transitions through EU-Africa collaboration.
